American NRNs and NRNA USA members have a hope towards the Association and would like to work with the International Coordination Council (ICC) to monitor organizational ethics and pave path towards streamlining the objectives of NRNA. In the name of Annual General Meeting (AGM) and unnatural bylaws amendment amidst COVID in NRNA NCC USA, **Biswa Nath Baral**, a highly controversial person who has repeatedly facing allegations through legal actions in the past and is also currently facing court case for conducting biased and unethical elections is being reportedly proposed again as the next Election Commissioner of NRNA NCC USA .

This communication is not to discuss the current judiciary action against criminal act of the illegitimate National Coordination Council (NCC) leadership.
