

- Collaborating with KU to create a learning hub for headmasters and teachers















TOWARDS OUR PARTNERSHIP

- I. **A partnership in transparency** where **YOU** bring the contacts at the local levels, it becomes your project for your community
 - You obtain the local contact and pass it on
 - \sim You obtain the agreement from your Board or group of friends or alumni in the US
 - \sim You fundraise for the project as well as we do, and the funds will be consolidated and sent to AO NEPAL
- 2. A partnership in transparency where WE bring:
 - AO NEPAL team and our Project Coordinator
 - We manage to get the MoU signed between the school and AO NEPAL
 - We have the know-how of installing Computer Learning Environment Centers™
 - We finance Between 30% and 50% of total equipment cost
 - We assist to recruit the teachers to use $CLEC^{TM}$ for ICT
 - We organize and manage the project from the ordering of equipment to the transportation, delivery, and installation on site
 - We support you in the USA with presentations to your community, and offer a special place on our website as well

OUR STEP #3: Possible "Scouting" trip for AO Nepa and Preparing Memorandum oF Understanding

OUR STEP #4: DEFINING THE FUNDRAISING PLAN and Deadlines that will go into STATEMENT OF WORK for Project

#1 PREPARE WITH AO US a FUNDRAISING PLAN and MoU based on project scope #2Define responsibilities, timelines, budget that includes equipments, transportation, installation, teachers recruitment and schedules, etc.

CHECKLIST EXPLAINING MAIN STEPS USED BY AO US to be used by US NEPALI ASSOCIATION

- I. STEP I CHOOSE: the Location, Rural Community, High School or remote college campus
- 2. STEP 2 CONNECT with the Municipality, Mayor, and School Principal, then School management committee \rightarrow you also ESTABLISH CONNECTIONS WITH ALUMNI OR GROUP OF DONORS
- 3. STEP 3: AO NEPAL organizes scouting trip to confirm project feasibility and get Memorandum of Understanding between ALL PARTIES started
- 4. STEP 4: US NEPALI ASSOCIATION and AO US prepare separate fundraising plans. Formal MoU is signed between ALL Parties.
- 5. STEP 5: ONCE MOU IS SIGNED, we follow the STATEMENT OF WORK that indicates the milestones of the project

 \rightarrow EACH PARTY FUNDRAISE, AND AFTER FUNDS ARE RAISED, THEY ARE CONSOLIDATED through AO US and SENT TO AO NEPAL, then AO NEPAL executes PROJECT on TIME, on BUDGET.
